- The Social Justice Center has made a request for neighborhood support and coordination to place porta potties in McPike Park to serve neighbors. MPD is against this, but a community meeting to bring together all stakeholders to discuss the issue is in the process of being scheduled.
- Officers Davila and Dower walked Willy Street last week to greet residents, and traffic was a common concern.

Alder's Report: Davy Mayer

- A porta potty will be put in McPike Park this summer as a stopgap due to the permanent restrooms having been damaged last summer.
- The board brought up the issue of the Loop the Lake race that is concurrent with the first day of Waterfront Festival. Due to safety and accessibility concerns, the Festival Committee has requested re-routing part of the race to avoid Yahara Place.
- Davy updated the board about Breese Stevens plan to enclose some of the public sidewalk and road for patrons and alcohol sales before a small number of 2025 concerts.
- Davy was assigned to the following committees: Urban Design, City County Homeless Issues, Sustainable Madison, Downtown Coordinating Committee.

Willy Street Park Society Briefing: Bill Jolin and Diane Michaelski Turner

- Willy Street Park is private land, but operates similar to a public park. All are welcome.
- Willy Street Park Society is working with Wisconsin State Historical Society to create an archive and oral history of the park (which was originally founded to prevent a Taco John's from operating on the property).
- The annual Willy Street Park Plant Sale is Saturday, Mary 3.
- Neighbors are invited to pick up trash they see anytime they enter the park, and volunteers are always needed for a variety of tasks from gardening to administration.

Save Our Songbirds (SOS) Briefing: Lisa Gaumnitz

- An event last week to promote SOS was partially funded by an MNA grant.
- SOS supports advocacy and tools for individuals to support bird habitats, including the promotion
 of bird-friendly coffee and cocoa, how to create bird-safe glass in your home, and more.
- A variety of materials were shared in an effort to support bird life on the Isthmus and beyond.

President's Report: Marlisa Kopenski Condon

- Syd Boyum Sculpture Maintenance: The board discussed previous agreements with the city regarding MNA's responsibility to maintain and repair a number of Sid Boyum sculptures and identified a working group to gather information and make recommendations to the board as to how to move forward.
 - This working group will include Elle, Lindsay, Del, Cailey/Eric, and Marlisa. Brian Standing will consult with the group.
- Eric sent a website overhaul update to the board, and an early June launch is planned for the new site.
